

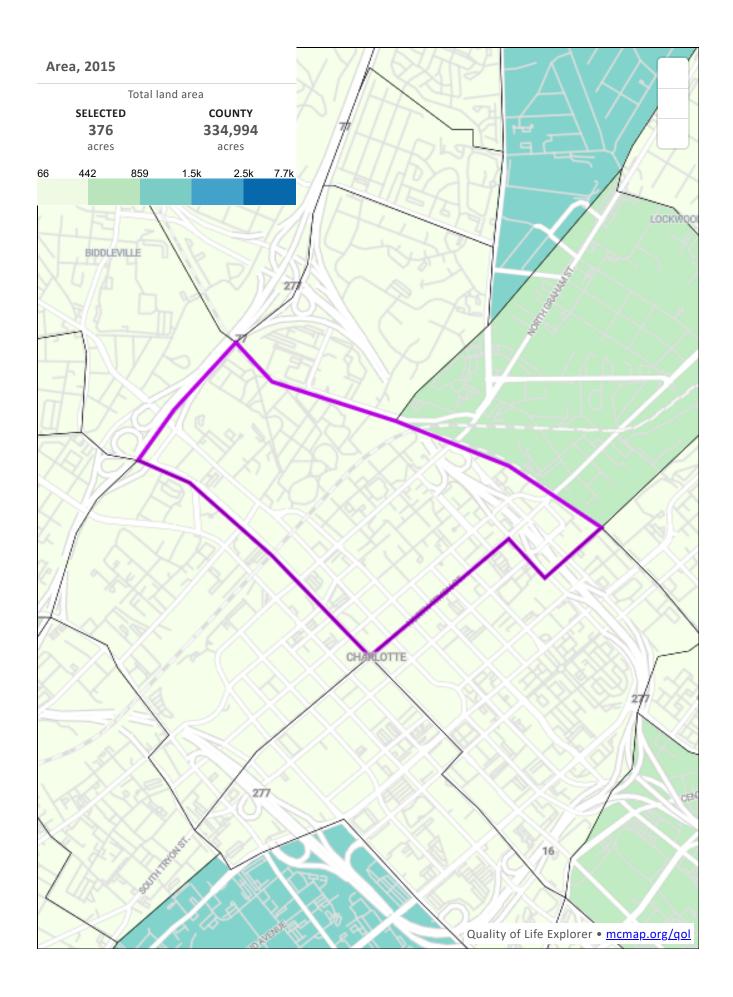
Summary Report
